## **Keynote Speakers**



#### Endocrine and Head & Neck Surgical Pathology Professor Bruce M. Wenia

Chair and Senior Member, Dept of Pathology, Moffitt Cancer Center Professor of Oncologic Sciences at University of South Florida, Tampa, FL, USA

Bruce M. Wenig, MD, is Chair and Senior Member in the Department of Pathology at the Moffitt Cancer Center, Tampa, Florida (2018-current) and Professor of Oncologic Sciences at the University of South Florida. Dr. Wenig completed a residency in Anatomic and Clinical Pathology at the Mount Sinai Medical Center New York, NY (1981-85). Following completion of his residency training, he took fellowships in Surgical Pathology at Cedars Sinai Medical Center Los Angeles, CA (1985-86) and in Otorhinolaryngic Head and Neck Pathology at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology Washington, DC (1986-87). Subsequently, he became a Staff Pathologist in the Department of Endocrine and Otorhinolaryngic Head and Neck Pathology at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology where he remained for 11 years. During this period Dr. Wenig was appointed as the Chief, Division of Otolaryngic Pathology and then the Assistant Chairman. He served on active duty in the United States Navy with honorable discharge (1987-1994). In 1998 Dr. Wenig became the Vice Chair for Anatomic Pathology in the Department of Pathology at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in the Bronx, NY. In 2001 he became the Director of Anatomic Pathology in the Department of Diagnostic Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the Beth Israel Medical Center, and St. Luke's and Roosevelt Hospitals, New York, NY, and subsequently was named Chairman of that Department (2004-2016).

Dr. Wenig has published 144 articles, over 90 book chapters and is co-editor or single author of 3 textbooks primarily in the areas of Head and Neck Pathology, and Endocrine Pathology. His Atlas of Head and Neck Pathology 4th edition will be released for publication in November 2023. Dr. Wenig is an acknowledged national and international authority on Head and Neck Pathology, and Endocrine Pathology, and is an invited lecturer throughout the world.



#### Gastrointestinal (colorectal)

#### Professor Iris D. Nagtegaal

Radboud University, Nijmegen, The Netherlands

Iris Nagtegaal is a professor of Gastrointestinal Pathology at the Radboud University in Nijmegen, the Netherlands since 2013. She studied both Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at the University of Leiden, the Netherlands, where she graduated in 1998 and 1996. She pursued her PhD at the same university and graduated with honors in 2002 ("Pathological aspects of rectal carcinoma", AstraZeneca Research Award for the best gastrointestinal PhD thesis in the Netherlands). She did her pathology training at the Radboudumc and Leeds University. Subsequently, she became a fellow of the Dutch Cancer Society and further trained in pathology (Netherlands Cancer Institute), population screening (Falun Lasarett, Sweden), molecular pathology (Baylor College Houston) and mathematical statistics (Queen Mary University of London).

After returning to Nijmegen, she has published over 400 peer reviewed papers (H factor 92), supervised over 25 PhD students and given over 100 international invited lectures. She is editor of the WHO Classification of tumors of the digestive system (5th edition), was chair of the Dutch nationwide pathology databank Palga (2010-2023), Series champion of the ICCR digestive tract datasets, expert panel member for lower gastrointestinal cancer of the UICC (2011-2019) and AJCC (from 2020), director of the Advanced Training Center of the European Society of Pathology for Colorectal Cancer Screening and Chair of the European Society of Pathology Taskforce for Synoptic reporting.



Neuropathology

#### Professor Fausto J. Rodriguez

Chief of Neuropathology, David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, Los Angeles, CA, USA

Dr. Fausto J. Rodriguez is currently professor, chief of neuropathology and neuropathology fellowship director at David Geffen School of Medicine at University of California Los Angeles (UCLA). Dr. Rodriguez completed training in anatomic pathology and neuropathology at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN, followed by a neuro-oncology research fellowship under a T32 training grant. After serving as senior associate consultant for two years, he moved to Johns Hopkins, Baltimore, MD (2010-2021) where he practiced more recently as professor of pathology, oncology and ophthalmology and director of the surgical neuropathology service. He is co-author of Neuropathology, Diagnostic Pathology Elsevier Textbook Series, now in its third edition. His clinical and research work aims to identify diagnostic, prognostic, and therapeutic biomarkers and targets in tumors of the central and peripheral nervous system, particularly those that develop in young patients and in the context of inherited tumor syndromes.

Consultant Pathologist, Auckland City Hospital, and Honorary Clinical Senior Lecturer, Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences at the University of Auckland.

Amanda is an anatomical pathologist, educator and researcher. She brings 20+ years of reporting and research experience from Melbourne, Sydney, Singapore, and NZ, to groups she collaborates with. Amanda has contributed to more than 40 peer-reviewed scientific publications, a WHO Classification of Tumours chapter, and several RCPA structured reports for cancer. She has a Google Scholar h-index of 21, (Scopus 18). Amanda is known for her diverse cross disciplinary research collaborations in biomedical science including digital pathology and quantitative analysis, animal models, medical education, artificial intelligence, and cognitive psychology. Pathology specific research areas include GI, liver, skeletal muscle, paediatrics, and ophthalmic. To become a better educator, Amanda has investigated how human brains apply diagnostic reasoning to visual pattern recognition in histopathology. In 2016 Amanda managed a project to open access to all RCPA members to 1000+ ecases library for education. At the University of Auckland Amanda facilitates faculty development workshops in elearning technology and visual science communication. Outside the lab, Amanda is to be found growing native NZ trees, reducing predators, maintaining fencing and managing a deer herd on her small farm.

Dr Siaw Ming Chai completed her Medical degree and subsequent Masters of Medical Science in Pathology at the University of Western Australia. 


